SeaPort-e Announces A second round of Open Enrollment!

August 2012 — Each year SeaPort-E invites companies to apply for SeaPort Contracts through an Open Enrollment. This year, Seaport, determined that they did not meet their new contractor goal in that annual enrollment and therefore decided to open a second round of Open Enrollment for this October, 2012. This is a great opportunity to apply for one of these potentially lucrative contracts about six months earlier than the standard window. This window will be open for 60 days, all contractors interested must have their offer submitted within that window or have to wait until Spring.
